Father Richard Memorial Fund Challenge




Many of you who are new to our parish may not know that last year, we acquired 3.6 acres of adjacent land for future expansion of our campus. This land includes the two homesites currently to our north, from Pleasant Run east all the way to the TexRail line. Fr. Richard, our longtime pastor who passed away in Dec. 2019, had the vision to purchase this valuable and for Good Shepherd's future expansion. Our original loan on the

property was \$1.5 million as of July 1, 2019. Through the generosity of our parish family, we have paid the loan \$325,000.00 balance down to Recently anonymous donors have offered up to \$150,000 in matching funds for any donations to the Memorial fund. 

The official rendering of our new pregnancy center! This building is where thousands of women, men, families, will meet the Truth! Where desperate Moms can tell their story to someone who will listen and care, and then work with her to eliminate the crisis, not the baby! **This is our mission!**

Chuck and I founded Mother & Unborn Baby Care 36 years ago. Sadly, Chuck passed away in January of 2016, but the center we founded goes on! So, why am I making this big move now? 
