## Weekly Reflection

### The Baptism of the Lord | January 10



**THE WATERS OF BAPTISM**  
When new sod is put in, it needs constant saturation with water. Landscapers say that this “knits” the sod to the soil. The same when a branch is grafted onto a tree: the poultice that joins them at the splice must be kept wet at all times. Water is the stuff that binds the very cells of our bodies together. No wonder religions throughout all times and cultures have used it so prominently. When Jesus stepped into the Jordan for baptism, he “knit” himself to what had come before him. By going to the Jordan, he made himself one with the people of Israel who had crossed it into their Promised Land. With John the Baptist, Christ wove himself into the prophetic tradition that heralded the coming reign of God. He had become fully human in the waters of Mary’s womb, and by partaking in the rite of the baptism of repentance, Jesus identified himself with our sinful, frail humanity. It is through the waters of baptism that Christ continues to graft new members onto his Body, the Church; through these waters we are cleansed from sin and filled with the promise of grace, given our destiny for eternal life. For us, as for Jesus, it is also the waters of baptism that inaugurate our mission to proclaim the Good News.

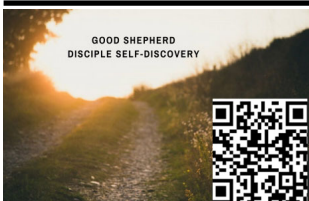

#### Are There Too Many People?

The claim that there are too many people in the world deserves further investigation. The idea of overpopulation became popular during

the Enlightenment period. British scholar Thomas Malthus (1766-1834) spread the belief that the more a population grows, the less it will be able to sustain itself, and eventually people will start starving and running short on other resources as a result of their own prosperity. American biologist Paul Ehrlich also supported this idea in the mid-twentieth century. Even though Malthus' and Ulrich's predictions have been proven to be wrong, the idea keeps resurfacing. It's what convinced China to implement a one-child policy, and India to force sterilization upon its population. Other policies around the world have been implemented to reduce our "carbon footprint". It's been said that some governments have even mixed sterilizers in their people's running water. Also, many people use the overpopulation myth to justify their lifestyle choices, like using contraceptives, and choosing to not start a family. Some people say we will soon run out of food, but farmers are actually being paid not to produce food because we've become so efficient at doing so. War, infrastructure, and politics are the real causes of starvation. G.K. Chesterton said, "The answer to anyone who talks about the surplus population is to ask him whether he is part of the surplus population, or if not how he knows he is not." The idea that the world is overpopulated is dangerous, because it gives people a reason to justify euthanasia and abortion. The overpopulation theory is not convicting enough to make a person sacrifice their own life for the cause, but it is persuasive enough to convince a person that other lives should be sacrificed. Many Christians in the past — and Christ himself — have given up their lives for the Christian ideals they believed in. A distinct quality of truth is that, when a person has committed himself to it, he is willing to sacrifice himself or something dear to him to stand up for it. While we are called to be stewards of the earth, the idea that humans are the problem is not only wrong scientifically; it erodes human dignity. Humans exist forever. The earth will not. Let's work toward taking care of the earth while understanding that saving souls is more important than saving our planet.

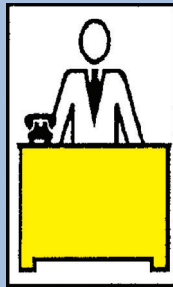

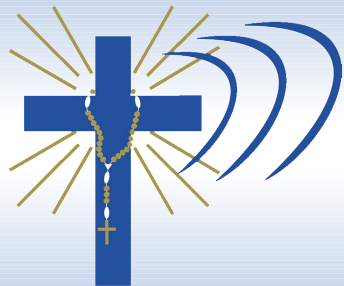
