## Weekly Reflection

### Fifth Sunday of Easter | May 2



#### BEARING FRUIT

Few of us, even when we meditate on the image of the vine and branches, stop to really think about how God “prunes” us. For some there is the danger of thinking that we are already producing fruit for the kingdom, in deed and truth as John says, perhaps raising a family, being active in our parish, and so on. But even those branches which are bearing fruit, the Gospel tells us, can be pruned to produce still more. Today Saul,

freshly “pruned” by his conversion, arrives in Jerusalem and meets resistance. Since he had been persecuting Christians, this was only natural. But even after he is accepted and begins to bear fruit, he meets further adversity, and his letters are filled with many accounts of how his trials “pruned” him to produce greater fruit for the kingdom. Like him, as long as we remain in Christ we will continue to bear fruit and, when the will of the Father determines it is time to prune us, the strength of the true vine must enable us to endure it. 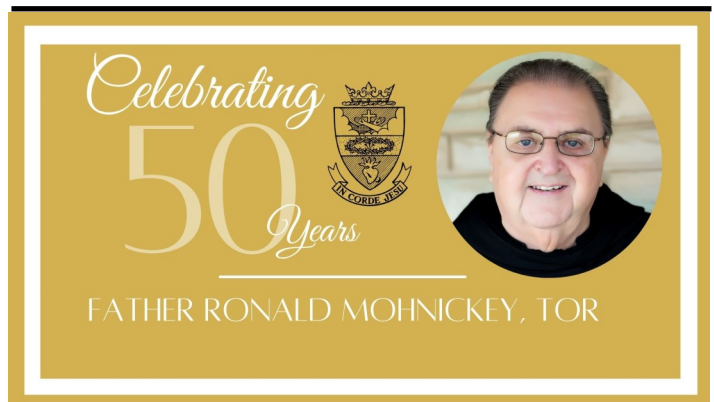

### Fr. Ronald’s 50th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood

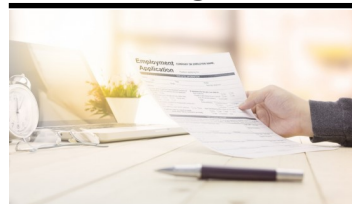

## Honduras Mission Appeal: May 15 & 16



This year we celebrate the 13 years of our covenant partnership with our Honduras Mission partner, the Fray Casimiro Cypher Institute in Olancho HONDURAS. With your continuous donations, prayers, and support, the staff and students of the Fray Casimiro Institute were able to face the many challenges presented during this past year. Many students returned to school the second week of February following a hybrid schedule to accommodate spacing and other restrictions. During the weekend of May 15 and 16, we will conduct our Annual Appeal to continue the great work we are doing in the community. In spite of the fact that Wilson Romero could not travel to visit us, we will share a video at all Masses so that you can hear firsthand an update of the current situation. It is incredible to see how much our

community has positively affected the lives of so many students and their community. With your generous donations during the Angel Tree Collection, we were able to help purchase textbooks for the students and to help provide modern technology equipment for virtual classes. Here at Good Shepherd, we renew our commitment to continue to work together to help the community, promote social justice, and to share our gospel values. We ask you to remember the students, their families, and the staff of our Honduras Mission Program partner. With your help we will focus on the following goals for our Honduras Mission Program in the coming year:

- Continue to provide funds to subsidize staff salaries
- Construction of dormitories for inter students
- Help purchase new supplies and equipment for the workshops, including: mechanics and motorcycle repair, electrician and cell phone repairs; hairstylist and barbers; handcrafts and agronomy
- Provide scholarships to selected students
- Support to relocate the water production plant to the new building

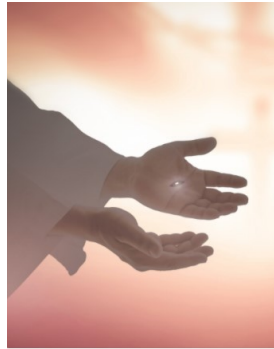

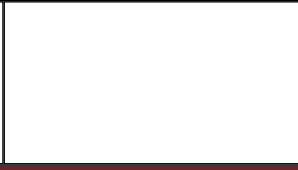
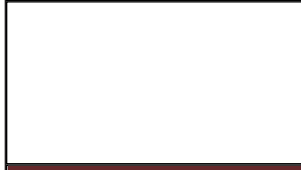
