Weekly Reflection

Sixth Sunday of Easter | May 9



THE PRESENCE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

We have a unique episode in the Acts of the Apostles today. A whole roomful of people are baptized with the Holy Spirit before they are baptized with water! The verb used—"the Holy Spirit 'fell' on them" (Acts 10:44)—

is characteristic of the way the Spirit works throughout the book of Acts: powerful and surprising. Though this "baptism" is not the normative way the New Testament describes baptism, it is still a good reminder today that the Holy Spirit is not controlled by whether or not we pour water, but rather that our sacramental signs reveal the presence of the Spirit at work among us. And we have a double reinforcement of how this work is accomplished from a Letter and a Gospel bearing John's name. It is love, self-sacrificing and self-giving love, that manifests the Spirit of Jesus in our midst. It is love that is the greatest of commandments. 



VBS will have minimal preparation, easy to follow instructions, and a video that leads kids step-by-step through each day. After months of virtual learning, many kids are already experiencing screen-fatigue. With that in mind, we feel we have struck the perfect balance between video content and in-person games and activities. And best of all... It is so simple!



Statement of Faith: Chris S



Growing up, I was raised in the Baptist church. My family was very active in the churches we were members of, especially my grandparents. Eventually that vigor would fade for me in college where I attended very few church services that weren't based around Christmas or Easter. I wasn't averse to religion, by any means, but had prioritized other parts of my life - sleep and laziness being the prime culprits. In college I met my now wife who was, interestingly enough, one of the first Catholics I had ever met. She had a passion for Christ that was readily apparent and that became a prominent feature early in our marriage. She never pressured me towards Catholicism and even encouraged me to attend other churches if that's where my heart led me. She was quick to follow with she'd still be going to Mass (as she should have)! I never gave much thought to converting to Catholicism until my children were in the picture. My priorities shifted drastically when I realized that my choices and decisions now had a direct impact on my little girls' formation. I'm sure other parents can empathize. Even still, I came up with many excuses like, "Timing's not right", "I'm too busy", "That's too much time away from my kids", "I'll do it later". I'm not sure when it happened, but eventually I recognized that prioritizing my faith would, at the same time, set the example to my girls that I'm trying to better my relationship with God and

myself. The lesson hopefully learned (if only subliminally) would be worth the small time away from my girls. Still, some hesitancy remained because I am, by nature, a questioner. So, my journey to full communion within the church hasn't been one caught up in an emotional and awesome spiritual awakening that some are lucky to experience. Initially a source of doubt, I'm coming to believe that what I felt as a lack of enthusiasm is actually the purpose to my story. It's ok if the journey isn't grand and bombastic. It doesn't have to be or feel that way. Not everyone needs a lightning bolt to strike to set action in motion, even if such a moment is their desire, because God knows that a soft whisper may be all that it takes. As for me, my girls were the gentle encouragement I needed to take the first step on a journey that will last a lifetime.

Chris came into full communion with the Catholic church at the Easter Vigil mass on Saturday, April 3rd, 2021.

During the weekend of May 15 and 16, we will conduct our Annual Appeal to continue the great work we are doing in the community. In spite of the fact that Wilson Romero could not travel to visit us, we will share a video at all Masses so that you can hear firsthand an update of the current situation. It is incredible to see how much our

community has positively affected the lives of so many students and their community. With your generous donations during the Angel Tree Collection, we were able to help purchase textbooks for the students and to help provide modern technology equipment for virtual classes. Here at Good Shepherd, we renew our commitment to continue to work together to help the community, promote social justice, and to share our gospel values. We ask you to remember the students, their families, and the staff of our Honduras Mission Program partner. With your help we will focus on the following goals for our Honduras Mission Program in the coming year:

- Continue to provide funds to subsidize staff salaries
- Construction of dormitories for inter students
- Help purchase new supplies and equipment for the workshops, including: mechanics and motorcycle repair, electrician and cell phone repairs; hairstylist and barbers; handcrafts and agronomy
- Provide scholarships to selected students
- Support to relocate the water production plant to the new building


