PARENTS

Please complete and submit to the office when you have all documents in-hand.

- 1. Complete "Initial Infant Baptismal Info" (see website)
- 2. Obtain from the Godparent(s) the completed "Certificate of Eligibility" form(s) (see website)
- 3. Submit a copy of the child's Birth Certificate.
- 4. Attend Baptism Prep Class. (see website to signup)
 - Baptism Classes are held once a month on Saturdays from 9:30 a.m. 11 a.m. at the parish. When you arrive, check in at the Parish Office Reception desk for the classroom assignment. You may also attend a class at a neighboring parish. If so, we'll need a verification of attendance.

GROUP BAPTISM SCHEDULING

- Please do not make travel plans prior to receiving contact from the Liturgy Department to schedule your Baptism date.
- Once we receive all completed documents laid out, the Liturgy department will contact you to supply ceremony details and schedule which upcoming group baptism you'd like to join.
- Group Baptisms are scheduled the first Sundays of the month at 12:30pm (immediately after the 11am Mass).
- No Baptisms are scheduled during Lent and Holy week.

DO YOU BELONG TO ANOTHER PARISH?

 Parents who do not belong to GSCC must provide documentation from their parish indicating permission from their Pastor for the Baptism to be celebrated at GSCC.

Infant Baptism Overview cont.

GODPARENTS

- Certificate of Eligibility (see website)
 - Parishioner of GSCC: fill out your portion and submit form to the office.
 - Parishioner from another parish: fill out your portion and have your Parish
 Priest verify sacraments, fill out his portion, sign it, and seal it with their Parish
 Seal (embossed/stamp). The original must be submitted to the Good
 Shepherd parish office Attn: Nic Gutierrez.
- If able, attend Baptism Prep Class" (cf. CIC 851.2)

GUIDELINES FOR CHOOSING GODPARENTS (CANON 872-874)

- Only one Godparent is required, but if you decide to have two, you must choose
 one male and one female.
- The Godparents may not also be the parents of the child.
- A Godparent must be at least 16 years of age.
- A Godparent must have received all of the Catholic Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation.
- A Godparent must be a practicing Catholic; that is, living the Faith by regular Mass attendance, etc.
- If married, a Godparent must be in a union recognized as valid by the Catholic Church.
- If unmarried, a Godparent may not be cohabiting.
- A Baptized non-Catholic may stand alongside the sponsor in the ceremony as a "Christian Witness."
