1.	Personal-celebrate as a family; family sits together	Children sit together; families sit apart
2.	Recognition by priest and parishioners-name read at the beginning of Mass and called up at end of Mass by priest for a special blessing	Separate Mass for First Communicants and families; not celebrated with rest of parish. No individual names mentioned.
3.	Participation-First Communicant walks in entrance procession and gets to take up gifts with family	Only a few children would get to take up gifts
4.	Family receives communion together	Children receive communion separate from family.
5.	Extended Family Members such as Grandparents and Godparents have opportunity to travel great distances and to be present as a part of the family celebration with the child receiving First Holy Communion	Due to individual family schedules it is not possible for all Extended Family Members of each child in a group communion to travel on the same weekend to be present as a part of the family celebration with the child receiving First Holy Communion
