New mosaics and Stations of the Cross have been approved.</p> <p>More Adoration hours were added during Lent and those incremental hours have continued throughout 2022.</p> <p>The Unify event on Nov 16 will orient families to prayer – with a Call to Action at the end of the night.</p> <p>Monthly presence of HTCS at Masses has made a difference – more new families enrolled at HTCS for this school year as a result!</p> <p>Holy Half Hour is providing families with young children time in Adoration.</p>	<p>Ministry Leader web page “went live” on July 1 with information, training and tools for ministry leads.</p> <p>A standard tool to evaluate current ministries and approve new ministries has been developed.</p> <p>47 of 60 active ministries have provided updated information and are ready for new and established parishioners to join them.</p> <p>The Hwy 26/Good Shepherd Catholic Outreach Center is open and available.</p> <p>Key staff positions have been filled to support furthering the mission and vision of GSCC.</p>	<p>Engagement &amp; Ministry team met with new parishioners to get feedback on existing process.</p> <p>Pre-Covid new member welcome &amp; connect process has been adapted for 2022 and is ready to engage new volunteers.</p> <p>Catechist Training was conducted in August for anyone in the parish who is involved or would like to be involved in a ministry that intentionally preaches and teaches the faith. This includes all faith formation ministries, CRHP leaders, marriage mentor couples, RCIA, etc.</p>
