It is anticipated, the GSCC Men's Club will award at least five, \$3,000 scholarships to graduating seniors. The purpose is to reward students who have been active at Good Shepherd, in their faith, and to help reinforce their faith during their college years. Below are the criteria for awarding scholarships. This criteria consists of both Mass ministry involvement as well as volunteer activity outside of mass. While it is designed to be a complete list of necessary criteria, it is understood that this list may be incomplete in some areas. It is the Men's Club intent and desire that all GSCC high school seniors have the opportunity to earn these scholarships. A GSCC student may only earn one of these five scholarships. These awards are to be given to high school seniors, graduate students may not participate. Students should assume that the scholarship committee will confirm their participation level and/or activity with their references.

The deadline to turn in your records for this year's scholarship is April 15, 2022 by 5:00 p.m.
