WALK THROUGH OF THE MASS

A) INTRODUCTORY RITES

At the Chair before beginning:

- Entrance Procession (Singing unites us in one Spirit)
- Kiss Altar (Christ is Cornerstone and Rock of the Church)
- Sign of the Cross (Liturgical Prayer to Father through Son and in Holy Spirit, Sign of Baptism and Salvation)
- Greeting (Biblical Formula from the Gospel or St. Paul)
- Penitential Rite (Greek Kyrie, daily conversion and mercy of God)
- Gloria (Hymn of Worship and Praise to the one God)
- Opening Prayer (Collect: Invitation to pray, theme and focus of the Mass celebration)

B) LITURGY OF THE WORD (Proclamation of the Word of God) At the Chair before the Readings:

- Synagogue Liturgy (2 readings, sing psalm, sermon and prayer)
- Catholic Liturgy (3 Readings from 3 year cycle, psalm, OT paired thematically with the Gospel, <u>Sit</u> for attentive listening of first 2)
- Gospel ***(<u>Stand</u> in honor, Alleluia, Trace the triple Cross)
- Homily (Explanation of the Word and Exhortation to apply it)
- Speakers (Spiritual Addresses to build up our Community)

At the Chair after the Homily:

- Creed (Profession of Faith: Nicene-Constantinople Creed in 325)
- General Intercessions (Jewish origins: petitions, needs of world and Church)

C) LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST (Proclamation of Actions of Christ) At the Chair before Gifts brought forth:

- Preparation of the Gifts (Bread and Wine, <u>Sacrifice</u>, self-offering)
- Commingling (Drop of Water = Church mixed with Wine = Christ)

At the Altar before offering the Gifts:

- Blessing Prayer (Jewish Liturgy)
- Washing Hands (Jewish ritual purification by Temple priests)
- Prayer over the Gifts (Asking God to accept our gifts)

At the Altar before the Preface:

- Preface (Introduction and Invitation to give thanks to God, Sanctus welcomes the holiness of God)
- Eucharistic Prayer (<u>Kneel</u> in thanksgiving to God for Jesus, the Spirit is called down to bless the gifts of bread and wine)
- Consecration *** (Institution of Eucharist separating Christ's Body and Blood in sacrifice, Memorial of dying and rising)
- Great Amen (Trinity, Doxology)

At the Altar before the Our Father:

- Communion Rite (Lord's Prayer and Sign of Peace)
- Breaking of Bread (Lamb of God, commingling Bread and Wine as one person, Passover <u>Meal</u> of taking, blessing, breaking and giving)
- Communion Procession (Sign of full communion with the Catholic Church, Catholic Identity, <u>Bow</u> in reverence before receiving)
- Blessing for those not receiving (Welcome to all in the assembly)
- Prayer After Communion (Silence that Sacrament may bear fruit)

D) CONCLUDING RITE

At the Chair the Announcements:

- Announcements (Weekly Notices and Special Recognitions)
- Final Blessing (Mission and Sending forth)
- Recessional (Going forth to live the Word and Eucharist)
